For Pat and Bob Bade, finding dental care for their two adult sons was a nightmare. Both men are on the autism spectrum and nonverbal. Because of your generous support, Craig, 44, and Kevin, 41, now have a dental home at St. Ann Center's Gardetto Family Community Dental Clinic.

"Dentist after dentist told us they couldn't treat them because they can't sit still and sometimes won't open their mouths," Pat said. It had been years since their sons had seen a dentist when the Bades heard about St. Ann Center's clinic—the only one in Wisconsin designed exclusively to treat people with physical and cognitive disabilities.

Craig and Kevin are now getting regular cleanings, X-rays and other procedures as needed. The large operatories offer space for their parents to stay with them throughout their checkup. What the Bades appreciate most about this unique special needs clinic is its compassionate staff.

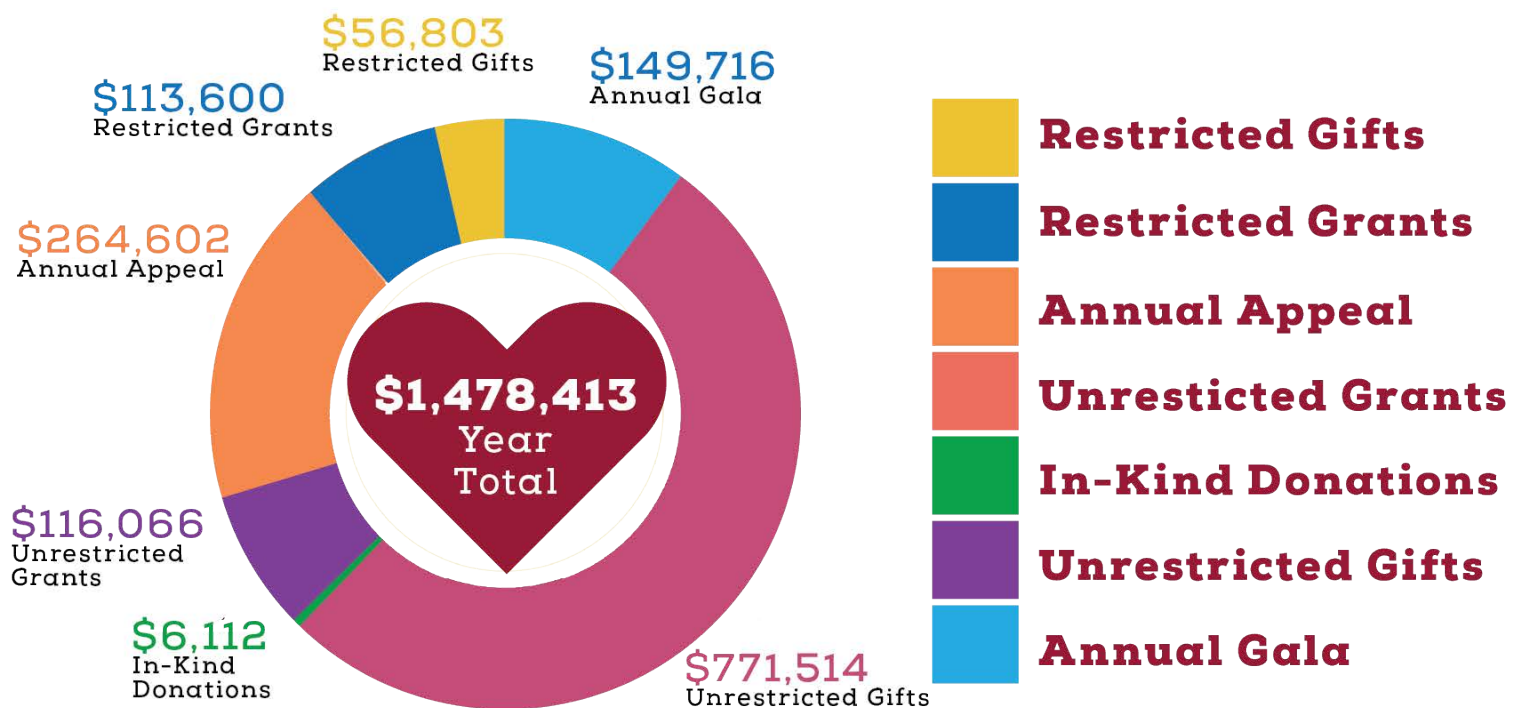
